From the President's Desk

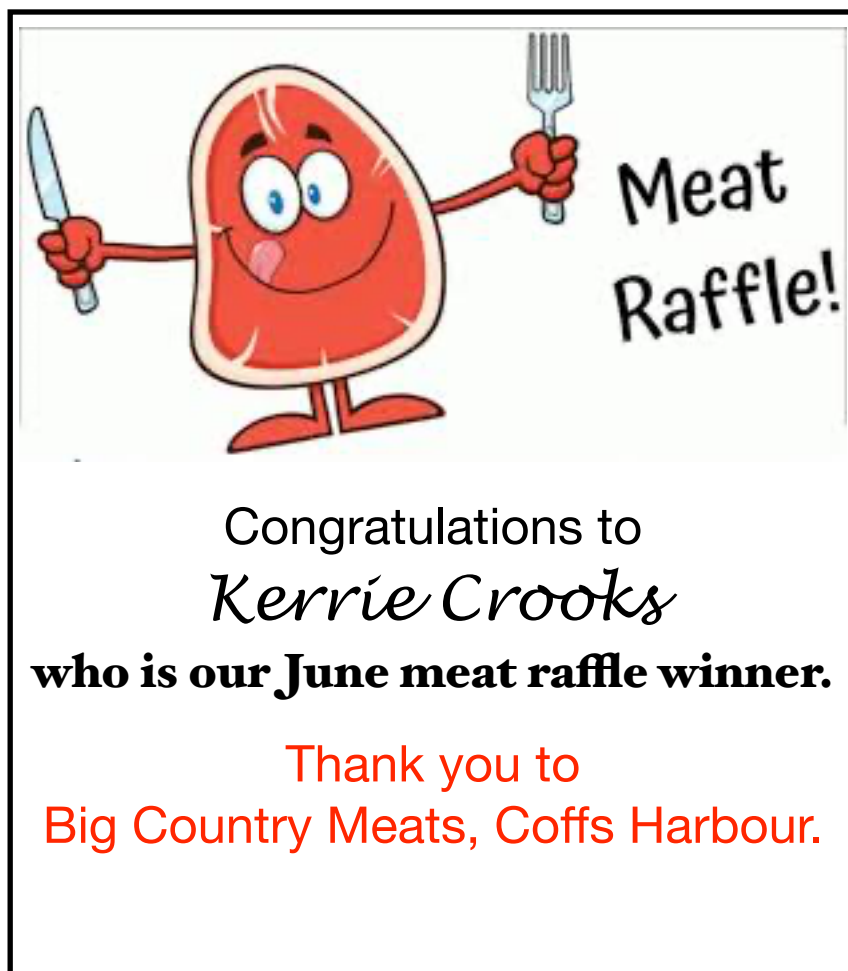
Well done to all those that came to play and make donations to "The Greatest Morning Tea". It was so good to see so many bring cakes and slices in to help make the event a success.

at Sawtell Croquet Club

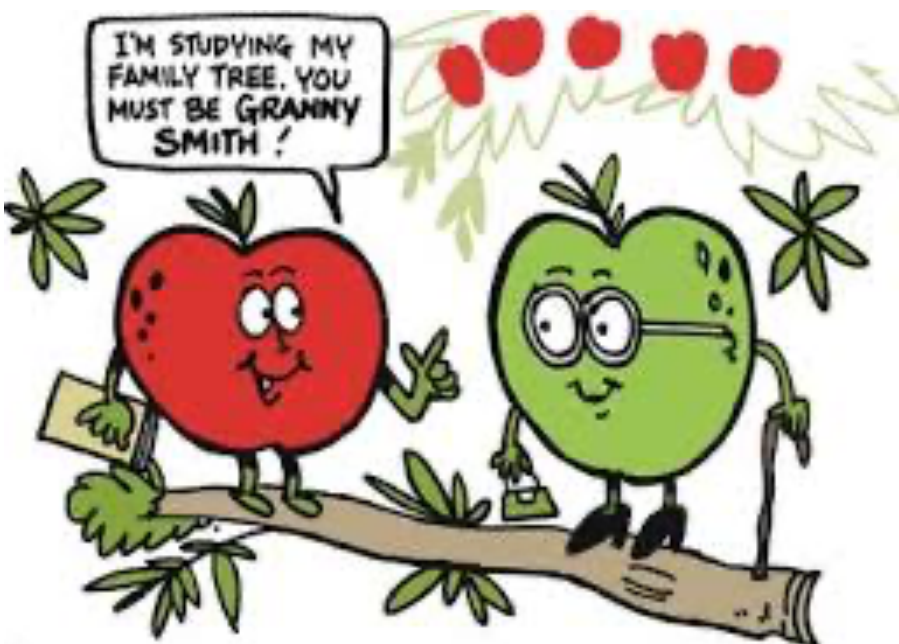
Workshops will focus on the key areas of skills, laws and tactics. Further workshops will be on the second Wednesday of the next month.

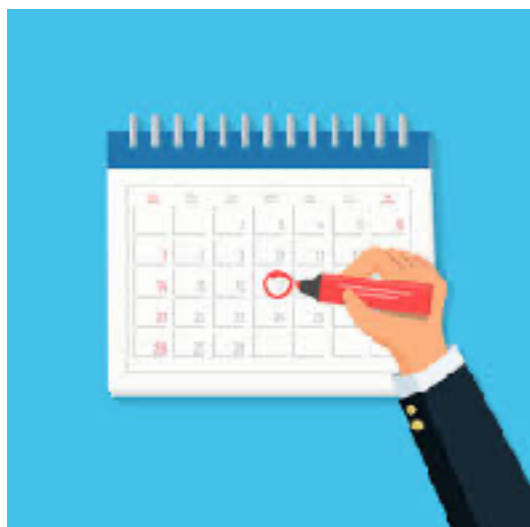
