Chocolate Slice Recipe



Base

250g pkt Nice biscuits
1 tablespoon cocoa
125g melted butter

Press combined mixture into 18cm x 28cm greased rectangular dish.

Filling

220g white marshmallows
125g chopped dark chocolate
1/3 cup of milk

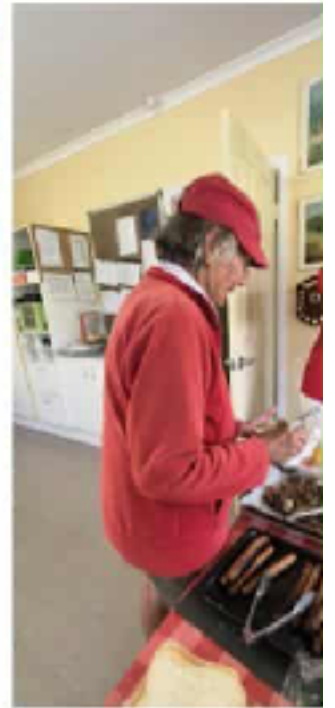
3 teaspoons gelatine dissolved in 1 tablespoon of water

2 cups of whipped cream

Melt marshmallows, chocolate and milk in top of double saucepan or in microwave. Add whipped cream and dissolved gelatine. Pour onto base and refrigerate.

Topping

Whip one cup of thickened cream. Spread onto slice and decorate with grated chocolate.

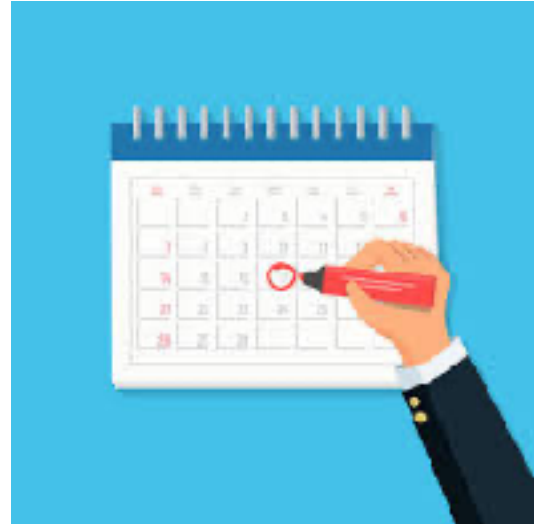
